Nurse's Notes

Clinic Clothing Needs:

I am running very low on boys winter pants in the clinic. If your child has borrowed clothes from the clinic, please return them as soon as possible. If you have boys pants that you would like to donate, they would be appreciated and put to good use.

Community Health Resources:

I wanted to make you aware of a few programs offered for your health needs. Jane Pauley Community Health Center is a low cost medical clinic offered to provide affordable health care for families. They have a sliding fee scale if you do not have insurance, and they can help you to apply for insurance. There are several Jane Pauley Clinics in the Indianapolis area, but the closest is located at Howe High School, 4900 Julian Avenue, phone (317)808-0672. Another low cost resource is the Jane Pauley Dental Clinic located at 9651 E 21st Street, phone (317)532-6150. Dental appointments are available year-round for adults and children with daytime and evening hours.

Community Network has set up a referral line at (317) 621-2727. If you are new to the area or searching for a provider accepting new patients, they can make a referral for a pediatrician, internal medicine provider or a family practice provider. They are able to tell you if the provider accepts your insurance plan in most cases. If you have any questions about these services, feel free to call me in the clinic at 860-4289.
