Additional activities planned for next week:

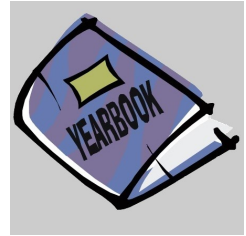
- Grades 3-5 will learn about making wise/healthy choices during guidance lessons.

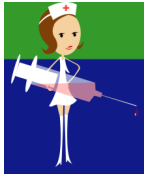


Dear Adams Families,

Immunizations: Exclusion Date 9/22/2015

If your child needs an immunization to be up to date with state standards, I have been contacting you by letter or phone. I will work with you to schedule appointments, and I have several resources for low cost immunizations, but the deadline for compliance is Tuesday, September 22nd. Please schedule your appointments and bring me the updated shot record after obtained or have the record faxed to 317-862-7255. We do not want any student to miss instruction time due to missing immunizations. **Students who are not up to date with immunizations on Tuesday, September 22nd will be excluded from school.**

Notice of Vision Screening

On Tuesday September 29th, the Marion County Health Dept. will be at Adams Elementary to perform vision screening. All children in the first grade, third grade, fifth grade, any student who is new to Marion County, and children from other grades suspected of having a vision problem will be screened this day. (Students in first grade will also receive a more thorough exam by the eye doctors at Best in Sight in October) Please mark your calendars for this important day. 

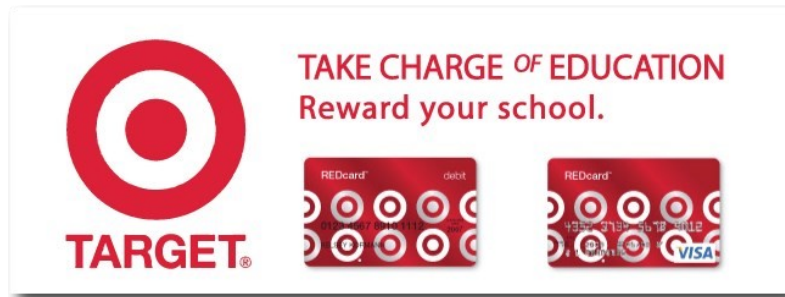

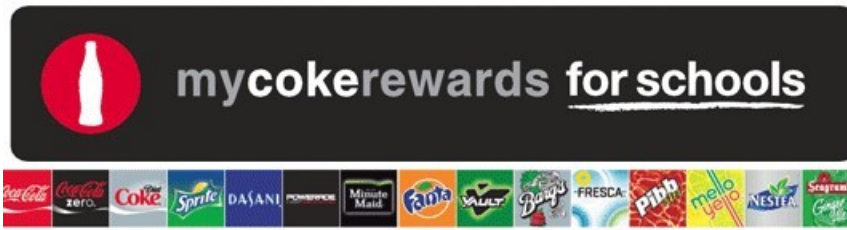
