## Nurse Notes

I wanted to make our families aware of two illnesses that are occurring in our community. Currently, I have had NO confirmed cases of either illness, but I want you to be informed. Marion County is currently experiencing an outbreak of shigellosis, which is a potentially serious diarrheal infection. Students with diarrhea cannot attend school until they have been asymptomatic (without diarrhea) for at least 24 hours. Students in grades one through twelve diagnosed with shigellosis must be excluded from school until they complete at least 48 hours of an appropriate antibiotic and are asymptomatic (without diarrhea) for 24 hours. Shigellosis is highly infectious and easily passed from one person to another. It is spread through the fecal to oral route—this can occur when an infected person has a bowel movement and then a germ is transferred from hand to mouth. Hand washing is the best way to prevent the spread of shigellosis. Shigellosis can live for four days outside the body on common objects. Surfaces such as toys, toilet flush handles, toilet seats, faucet handles, counters and door knobs should be disinfected frequently. A person who has had shigellosis can continue to spread the germ for up to 30 days after they are well if they are not treated with an appropriate antibiotic. Please call your child's healthcare provider or the Marion County Public Health Department at (317) 221-2117 if anyone in your family has an illness similar to what has been described.

The second illness is Enterovirus-D68. Enterovirus D68 (EV-D68) is a less common type of enterovirus, but is not new. EV-D68 can cause mild to severe respiratory illness. Mild symptoms may include fever, runny nose, sneezing, cough, body and muscle aches. Severe symptoms may include difficulty breathing and wheezing. Some individuals, especially those with underlying conditions, such as asthma or a weakened immune system, may experience more severe complications including difficulty breathing. Like a cold, EV-D68 is spread through respiratory secretions, such as mucus, saliva, and viral particles in the air after infected people sneeze or cough. There is no vaccine against EV-D68, and no specific treatments for people with respiratory illness caused by the virus. Many infections will be mild and self-limited, requiring only supportive care for their symptoms. Children with underlying conditions may need more intensive treatment and should be seen by their health care provider. Alcohol-based hand sanitizers are NOT effective against EV-D68, which is why handwashing with soap and water is so important. Remind your child to cover their cough (in sleeve) and to wash hands with soap/water for at least 20 seconds especially prior to eating and after restroom.

Notice of vision screening:

On **Tuesday September 30th**, the Marion County Health Dept. will be at Adams Elementary to perform vision screening. All children in the third grades, fifth grades, students who are new to Marion County, and children from other grades suspected of having a vision problem will be screened this day. Please mark your calendars for this important day. Please contact Mrs. Davis at 860-4289 for questions.

All 1<sup>st</sup> grade students will have vision screening done on **Wed. Oct. 1**, through the generosity of Drs. Huffman, Rich and Potter, optometrists in Franklin Township Corporation. FT buses will transport students to and from the screening, held at Kitley Elementary School. 1<sup>st</sup> graders will be screened in accordance with IN law, using the Modified Clinical Technique, a group of tests designed to determine the presence of any vision difficulties. The four parts include visual acuity, eye muscle balance, retinoscopy, and ocular health. Good vision is essential to learning. Please contact Mrs. Davis at 860-4289 for questions.

### Counselor Corner

Dear Parent/Guardian:

This year, I will conduct small groups for any students in grades 1-5 who have experienced a loss/change within their family in the past. At this time, I am forming these groups for the 2014-2015 school year. Any student who has had a death in the family and/or is living in a non-traditional family due to a change such as separation, divorce, remarriage, deployment, etc. is invited to join one of these groups. Children who have previously participated in such a group are welcome to join again.

It is common for children who have experienced such changes to feel isolated. These support groups give them a chance to express themselves. It is also a chance to help them realize that they are not the only person to experience this kind of loss. Research has shown that children may need help learning to cope with important changes in family life so that they can succeed in school and socially with others.

I conduct these groups at school during the school day. Each group meets for 30 minutes weekly for approximately 6 weeks (during lunch time). Your child's group will be comprised of children of the same age and/or circumstances whenever possible. A signed permission form must be returned before a child may participate in the group. You will find this form at the bottom of this page.
